

The 2020 Golden Spread Classic will be implementing the following procedures to abide by the safety protocols recommended for events and for those who will be attending and/or participating in the show.

1. All persons should follow social distancing guidelines as recommended by the State of Texas and Centers for Disease Control. Maintain 6 feet of distance between people.
2. Practice good hygiene-wash hands for at least 20 seconds, use hand sanitizer, avoid touching face.
3. Masks are recommended but not required.
4. Do not gather in large groups. Please stay with the people you traveled with to the show.
5. Any person sitting in the stands must maintain a safe distance from others by only using alternate rows and leaving at least 2 empty seats between other people not associated with your family.
6. If you or anyone in your family has experienced any possible symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea or any fever greater than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit then DO NOT ATTEND.
7. If you have had close contact with a person who is symptomatic or tested positive of COVID-19 in the last 14 days then DO NOT ATTEND.
8. If you have been tested for COVID-19 but do not have the test results then DO NOT ATTEND until you have received a negative test result.
9. If you or anyone in your family has been infected by COVID-19, DO NOT ATTEND until you are medically cleared to return to normal activities.
10. At-risk people are strongly encouraged to not attend.

All persons attending and/or participating in the Golden Spread Classic understand the potential spread and risk of COVID-19 and the severe illness and potential death of the disease. All persons attending and/or participating accept the risk and agree to indemnify and the Golden Spread Classic, volunteers, participants, vendors, Hockley County, employees and any other person associated with this activity harmless from any liability, injury, illness or death that may arise due to participation in this event.
